Driving Directions You have to take the A367 from Bath, direction to Wells and Radstock. Turn right on the B3115 after about 1.3 miles after the last roundabout in Bath at the park and ride on the outskirts of Bath. Continue driving for 3 miles on the B3115. Don't turn left on Camerton Rd at the sign Camerton Church or Camerton 1,4 miles. Continue direction to the Recreation Centre and Timsbury, for about a hundred yards until you come to a place where the B3115 has a sharp turn to the right to Timsbury and left to Radford and Paulton on Weekesley Lane.

Camerton Hall is on the left when the Road forks of there is a big gate on the right of the hall you need to turn left at the fork on Weekesley Lane for a few yards to get to the gate.
